Cost: 3 euros

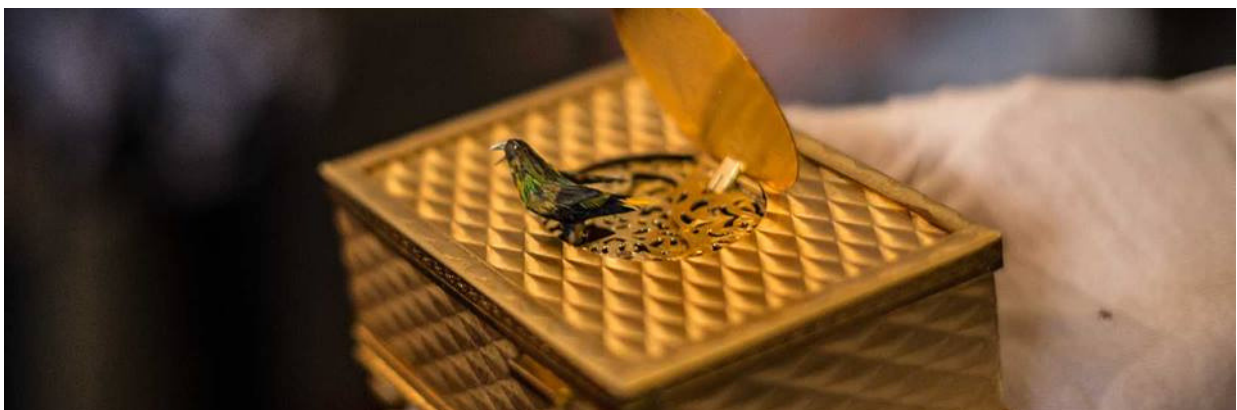

A WALK THROUGH MUSIC AND POETRY

Musicalia Museum in Villa Silvia Carducci, Cesena (FC)

Duration: 30 minutes

Cost: 2 euros

Description: Walk through the paths of the Talking Literary Garden, with explanations from the guide alternating with audio commentary with music and speech. Voices of actors will play the famous characters who attended and have made Villa Silvia famous. Among the many thinkers, musicians and artists who attended it, in addition to the Countess Silvia and the poet Carducci, there are also Giovanni Pascoli and the tenor Bonci. Following is a visit to the Carducci Room and the Salotto della Contessa. The poet's room presents itself to the visitor exactly as the poet left her during his last stay, which took place in 1906, the year in which he won the Nobel Prize. Time seems to have stood still in the Salotto della Contessa, in which the noblewoman's piano stands out, together with the personal effects of the Pasolini-Zanelli family. The route aims to make visitors know the history of the area, analyzing the close link between the Countess Silvia and the poet Carducci, in a magical timeless atmosphere
